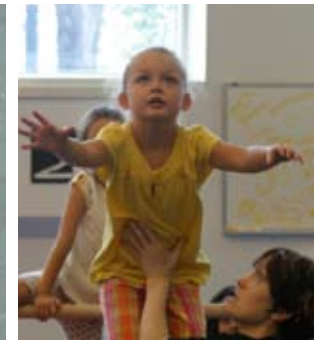


Liberty Science Center
