

Asphalt Green Swim School Requirements

Evaluations: 5 years and older only

Evaluations are for children new to Asphalt Green's Swim School that are already deep water safe and would like to register for a class above beginner two. The following dates are Swim School Evaluation Days in which our instructors will evaluate your child prior to the start of class and provide you with the class recommendation for our terms. Evaluations are available by drop-in on Evaluation Days. **Note:** Previous class and teacher recommendations are recorded and kept on file for continuing students.

Saturday 10:00am - 2:00pm

Sunday 10:30am - 2:30pm

Important Class Policies / Viewing and Graduation Days

- Parent Visitation Days: Parents may watch classes from the pool deck on the first day, mid-term, and last week of the session. For all other classes, parents are not permitted on the pool deck. Please refer to our Swim School Calendar for exact dates.
- Kids not toilet trained, or ages 4 and under, must wear non-disposable, rubberized pool diapers that fit tightly around their legs in addition to regular, disposable water diapers.
- Placements are subject to change based on the instructor evaluation during class.
- Progress reports are sent home with students to indicate their levels of achievement at the middle and end of each term.
- Bathing caps must be worn by anyone whose hair falls below his or her ears or touches his or her collar.
- Make-up classes are limited to one per term and subject to availability. If Asphalt Green cancels a class, we will make every effort to provide a make-up opportunity. No refunds are available for missed classes. To schedule a make-up, please email swimschool@asphaltgreen.org
- Graduation Week: All children take part in graduation week on the last day of classes. This is a great time to celebrate the season of swimming and all that they have learned.
