## SET-UP:

## STUDENTS FORM A CIRCLE

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 15 +
TIME: 10 MINUTES +

## EXPLAIN

1 Let's form a circle! 1 student will be "It" and will start in the middle.
2 "It" will close his/her eyes for 10 seconds while the other students pass the coin (small object) around the circle.

3 "It" will open his/her eyes and will try to guess who has the coin.
4 If correct, then the student with the coin was caught "Red-Handed" and will switch places with "It."

5 If "It" is not correct, he/she will do 5 jumping jacks and try again.

## $\checkmark$ For Understanding:

- How many students are in the middle of the circle?
- What happens when the coin is found?


## GAME TIP:

- "It" is allowed 3 guesses


## CONFLICT RESOLUTION TIP:

- Have students high-five when switching places.


## OUTDOOR TIP:

- Create 2 or 3 smaller games.
