

Tickets & Admission:

Q: Do I need tickets if the event is free?

A: Yes. Admission is free, but all guests must claim tickets online in advance to help us manage capacity. You will receive a QR code that will be scanned upon entry to Litwin Field.

Q: What does a General Admission ticket include?

A: General Admission gives you access to the Street Fair, Haunted Maze, and Litwin Field. Each child (ages 2+) will receive 10 free activity tickets for Litwin Field rides.

Q: What is the Sensory-Friendly Hour?

A: From 2:30pm – 3:30pm, families that have children who experience sensory sensitivities, can enjoy Litwin Field and the Haunted Maze with reduced sound, lighting, and crowds. Tickets are limited for this special session.

Q: What is the Green Line Pass?

A: The Green Line Pass is a Haunted Maze fast-pass that lets you skip the regular line. Passes are capped at 6 per family and are non-refundable.

Q: Can a family re-enter the field if none of the children possess tickets?

A: Yes. There will be non-ticketed activities on the field as well.

Activities & Tickets:

Q: How do activity tickets work?

A: Each child age 2+ will receive 10 free tickets at entry to use on Litwin Field rides. Bonus tickets can be earned by visiting Street Fair vendors.

Q: Are activity tickets needed for everything?

A: No. Tickets are only required for Litwin Field rides. The Street Fair, Haunted Maze, Sundial Plaza, and select activities are ticket-free.

Q: Can I buy more activity tickets?

A: No. Additional tickets cannot be purchased. Guests may earn extra **free** tickets by interacting with our Street Fair vendors.

Q: What if I still have tickets when they leave/when the event ends?

A: You can use the remaining activity tickets to enter a free raffle upon exiting Litwin Field. The winner will be selected and contacted on October 27, 2025.



Q: Can children use their tickets on the same rides?

A: Yes. Children are free to use their tickets on the same ride. When they complete their turn, they will have to exit the activation and rejoin the line.

Event Logistics

Q: What are the entry and closing times?

A:

- Street Fair: 2:30–6:00 pm (lines close 5:45 pm)
- Litwin Field: 3:30–6:30 pm (gates close 5:30 pm, lines close 6:00 pm)
- Haunted Maze: 3:30–6:30 pm (lines close 5:30 pm)

Q: Can I leave and come back?

A: Yes! Hand stamps allow re-entry.

Q: What should I bring?

A: Costumes encouraged! Please bring clear or small bags for quicker entry. No outside food or drinks are allowed on the field.

Q: Why should I bring a clear or small bag?

A: Our security will do bag checks prior to your entry or re-entry to Litwin Field, Sundial Plaza, and the Haunted Maze. Clear or small bags will allow this process to be quicker.

Q: Will I have to check-in every time I re-enter Litwin Field, Sundial Plaza, or the Haunted Maze?

A: No. When you check-in, you will receive a hand stamp. This will allow for us to know you have checked. Upon re-entry, you will bypass the line by showing your hand stamp, go through bag check, and be allowed entry.

Q: Are strollers allowed on the field?

A: Strollers are allowed on the field but not in the haunted maze. Please note, there will be designated stroller parking in the Basketball Court, but we are not responsible for lost strollers or items. Strollers may not be left alone on the field.

Q: Can I bring a fake/prop weapon to the event?

A: While we understand your desire for creative expression, we prioritize the safety and comfort of all attendees. We strongly discourage the presence of fake or prop weapons. If such items are



deemed to pose a risk to others or are considered inappropriate, you may be kindly requested to store them away or exit the event to ensure everyone's enjoyment and safety.

Q: Am I allowed to bring pets?

A: Although we love all furry friends, pets are not allowed at the event. However, service dogs are permitted and welcome to assist those who require their support.

Q: Can I bring my own food and/or beverages to the event?

A: Outside food and drink are not permitted. We will have food trucks on-site with food and beverage options available for purchase.

Q: How can I make a donation?

A: Online anytime:

QR codes at the event:

To make online donations even more accessible, you'll find QR codes for donations displayed on signs throughout the event venue.

In-person at the event:

If you prefer to donate in person, you can do so at the event. Look for our donation stations at the main entrance and exit. We accept donations in various forms, including cash and card payments. We also support Apple Pay for your convenience.

Accessibility & Inclusivity:

Q: Are there accommodations for children with sensory sensitivities?

A: Yes, our Sensory-Friendly Hour (2:30–3:30 pm) provides a calmer experience. Sound levels gradually rise starting at 3:25 pm to prepare for the main event.

Q: Is the event wheelchair accessible?

A: Asphalt Screams is wheelchair accessible, including entry points, the Street Fair, restrooms, and most event areas. Please note that some individual activities on Litwin Field may not be accessible for all guests. Our staff and volunteers will be available to assist and help guide families to the best activities for their needs.

Q: What if my child cannot wait on long lines?

A: We provide Everyone Plays wristbands for event attendees that have trouble with long lines and need accommodations. You can receive one of these at our Cool Down Zone.
